

# Free School Meals

## Do you receive any of the following?

- Income Support
- Income based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income related Employment Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit - as long as you have a yearly household income of less than £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) and you do not get Working Tax Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working tax Credit)
- Universal Credit
- In the Armed Forces

## If you can answer yes to any of the above your child may qualify for Free School Meals & Pupil Premium

If your child qualifies for Free School Meals, Girnhill Infant School will also receive additional funding and this supports school greatly!

Entitlement to Free School Meals has benefitted many families throughout the pandemic.
