

KS1 Remote Learning Expectation

Registration and clinic Live - Microsoft Teams	
<p>Short registration session according to the timetable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Teacher and TA join first. You can have your camera on or off. - Children join to say good morning. <p>Say good morning, note who is present.</p> <p>Make sure that staff and parents know that they need to have mics off so that other users can't hear what is happening in their homes. This can be very awkward.</p> <p>Express that, children only need to come to clinic if they have any problems with their learning. Any other issues must contact school.</p>	
<p>Learning clinic session according to the timetable</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Teacher and TA join first. Again you can have your camera on or off. - Children join. <p>Talk about the work and answer any questions.</p>	

Daily Expectation	
Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upload daily lesson video to seesaw
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read your book to a grown up • Enjoy a story time together with your grown up
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upload writing focus of the day • Notes on what to use out of home learning kit to support task
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upload daily task with a verbal recording explaining process and what to use to support you. • Provide examples, progression in skills to support all learners • Upload WRMH lesson video if applicable. • Provide link/s to apps and websites to access games linked to task.
Storytime	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upload a link from cbeebies/storyline online to seesaw for parents to watch with children • Upload teacher reading story of the week to be listened to each day that week.
Weekly Expectation	
British Values – Picture News	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monday – upload photo and questions to discuss at home.
Wellbeing and Values	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tuesday – upload video of wellbeing story being read. Upload questions to ask children after reading the story
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wednesday – upload a science task to complete from home e.g. mini experiment or bug hunt
Wider curriculum	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thursday – provide task for Hist/Geog based around vocabulary and key information. • Include videos to watch, rhymes to remember
RE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Friday - upload task

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Always give guidance on what equipment in the Home Learning to use.

Let's be **READY** for our day of Learning

Up at normal school time.

Get dressed - no pjs!

Make yourself feel awake - washed, teeth brushed, hair combed

Have your equipment (pens, pencils, paper etc) at the ready!

Charge your laptop, phone, tablet, PC make sure you turn it all on and have it ready.

Sign in for your register in your time slot

Make sure you access your See Saw Work each morning, and return it to your teacher by 1.30pm.

Let's be **Respectful** and kind to each other!

In register time, wait for the adult to say your name.

In learning clinic time, use the "hands up". Be patient.

Remember this is school, so no inappropriate language and be polite, this is a must from everyone in your household.

Please and thank you are a must!

Complete the work your teachers set you on time.

Only pupils from the class should attend - parents to be close by. It is just like the classroom.

Please keep your microphones mute unless the teacher asks you to speak.

Keeping **Safe**

Remember, if you are worried about anything, we are all still here to help you.

Do not try to set up separate meetings with each other or with people you don't know.

Treat each other respectfully - bullying is bullying wherever it happens, and it is not allowed.

Work in a room in your house, but not the bedroom or bathroom.

Make sure that when your camera is on what you are showing to the rest of the class is appropriate.

You must not use any devices to record the lessons - just like in class you don't record lessons.

To do:

1. Use the laptops to practice signing in with your children (if you haven't done this already)
2. Practice recording over powerpoint slides we need to learn this together
3. Talk through what Ready Respectful and Safe looks like in home learning with the children
4. 2 weeks remote learning plan in case of staff illness
5. document of all remote learning opportunities i.e generators, websites etc
