Remote Learning - information for parents in the event of a whole class isolation

<p>How will your child access remote learning?</p> <p>We will set work that mirrors the school curriculum.</p> <p>Your child should access this through the see-saw app, each morning.</p>	<p>How will your child submit work and receive feedback from their teacher?</p> <p>Your child should submit their set work by 1.30pm each day. The remainder of day children can access uploaded stories and suggested websites to further support application of skills.</p> <p>The teacher can then check the work, provide feedback using the see-saw app, and amend their planning for the following day.</p>
<p>Appropriate clothing and environment for remote learning</p> <p>Ready, Respectful and Safe!</p> <p>Clothing appropriate for school please - no pyjamas</p> <p>In an appropriate room - not a bedroom or bathroom.</p> <p>Away from distractions (pets etc)</p> <p>Mute the audio when the teacher is talking please.</p> <p>Teaching staff will be following the Staff Code of Conduct and acceptable use of ICT policy as usual.</p>	<p>Registering and attendance</p> <p>Each day the teacher will arrange a teams call with the class to register attendance. The time for this will be communicated by the teacher to the class through see-saw.</p> <p>Pupils not present without an explanation will receive a phone call from the school office or learning mentor in line with usual attendance procedures.</p> <p>Parents should inform school if pupils are not able to attend remote learning by emailing GH-Enquiries@ipmat.co.uk</p>
