Minimum age: **18** 'Intense sequences of violence and action, thematic elements and brief strong language'



Call of Duty

Minimum age: **18**

'Suitable for adults only, for extreme violence, multiple motiveless killing and strong language'



Fall Out

Minimum age: **18**

'Frequent strong violence and language.'



Five Nights at Freddy's

Minimum age: **12**

'This makes the game much too intense for younger children and teenagers should know what they're getting into, a terrifying psychological thriller.'



Fortnite

Minimum Age: **12**

'Violence consists of you using whatever weapons you can find or make to fend off the monsters... its online nature could expose younger players to offensive language from random strangers via the voice or on-screen text chat.'
