Attendance

School attendance is so important to ensure that your child is reaching their full potential. We also appreciate that this time of year is going to be so tricky as it's the season for coughs and colds.

If your child is displaying one or any of the following symptoms:

Cough, temperature loss of smell or taste

then they will need a PCR test before they can come to school.

Please remember that the quicker you get them tested then the quicker (if negative) they can return to school. We want all of our children to attend school as much as possible, whilst at the same time keeping everyone as safe and well as possible.

Please can you remember to contact the school office each morning throughout the duration that your child is off school.
