Squirrels have been using their fine motor skills to cut their own fruit.



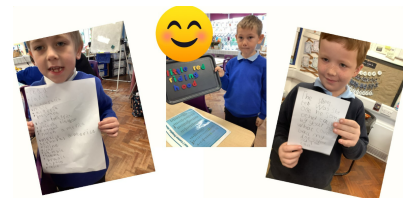
Badgers have been looking at the story 'Leaf Man' and creating their own designs using natural materials

Foxes have been practising their independent writing in provision. This includes spelling common exception words, making lists and writing stories


# Weekly Attendance
